Number of Voting Members

A minimum of two lay members (typically one man and one woman) are elected or appointed by each congregation in the synod as voting members

Additional lay representation from congregations shall be on the basis of the number of baptized members as reported in the most recently published ELCA Yearbook. Congregations over; 500-1500 baptized members can have four (2 men, 2 women) voting members; 1501-2500 baptized members can have six (3 men, 3 women) voting members; 2500 baptized members can have eight (4 men, 4 women) voting members.
